I am pleased to say that I have seen a real focus on improving these behaviours and using them to develop an effective learning environment. The next few weeks will focus on working with others – listening and learning from their ideas; respecting other people’s viewpoints; having empathy with others and learning from other people’s good learning behaviours. Our woodland creature that represents these characteristics is Betty Bee. I will be talking to the children about this in my assemblies and I will be looking for evidence of these characteristics in my classroom observations.
