#### **Dear Parents**

It's that funny time of year when we can get every season in one day, many children are finding that they don't have a coat in school as it was fine in the morning but by playtime it is raining. While we do, of course, have 'indoor play' when the weather is very bad, we do try to get the children out for fresh air and a run around if it's only a bit of drizzle. Even this morning we were fine, then a couple of drips, then a downpour – all within about two minutes!

#### SMALL THINGS MATTER

My assembly for the children today was entitled 'Small things matter' and was about a man who considered himself very important and started to boss people about and not appreciate the small things they do for him. Obviously, in the story he learnt his lesson and apologised to all those people. The link to our ethos was regarding every person in the school playing their part in the smooth running of the school – I thanked the children for playing their part in keeping the cloakroom tidy for instance. We discussed how important a job the cleaner does to keep the school a pleasant place to work, and also how important it is that the meal team assistants can do their job effectively so that the teachers can have their lunch (the children agreed that nobody wants a hungry teacher in the afternoon!) Over the past few weeks I have been monitoring the children's behaviour at various points in the school day and have noticed different attitudes at different parts of the day. Next week I will be monitoring this again and have told the children that I would like to see an improvement.

#### **TUCK SHOP**

Thank you all for your patience while we have been reviewing the tuck shop. With the recent information regarding sugary snacks we thought that we should investigate whether the tuck that we were offering fitted within government guidelines. After considering this we have re-stocked the tuck shop as follows: Yoghurt raisins, Yoghurt dates, Carob raisins, Yoghurt apricot and Yoghurt sunflower seeds. These are all suitable snacks and therefore usual service is now resumed – 30p a bag – available at morning play. No other snacks please.

#### **CHILDREN IN NEED**

The school council have expressed a wish to bring in teddies on pyjama day – I think as a one off this would be fine, as long as the child takes responsibility for the item. We will be letting the children come to school dressed in their pyjamas / onesies / dressing gowns on Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November in return for a donation to the Children in Need appeal. They can also have messed up bed-hair if they wish. Please ensure that shoes are worn rather than slippers and they also bring an outdoor coat, as they will still need to go out to play.
