Well done Year 6 for being so grown up and mature this week for the SATs tests. There was no drama, no worries and every single person was really trying their best – and that is all we ask. They have now been sent off for marking and we will receive the results on 9th July.

Year 2 SATs are marked internally and are used to inform the class teacher's assessments so will not be sent away anywhere – nor will the results of the tests be published.

Years 3, 4 and 5 will complete NFER tests over the coming weeks which will assess their understanding of the taught curriculum, highlight any gaps or misconceptions, and inform future planning and end-of-year report writing. Again, these are marked by the teachers in school and are not used for any external reporting.
